Spend four days immersed in all-things bass! The Fourth Annual Oklahoma Bass Bash will take place June 9-12, 2008 at Oklahoma State University. Designed for bassists between ages 12 and 18 with at least one year of playing experience, this 4-day camp will include private lessons, technique classes, bass ensembles, and a jazz workshop. Additional instruction on Oklahoma All-State and regional honors orchestra audition material will be provided.

This year, Horizons will host nationally-renown electric violinist Cathy Morris for a three-day residency; students will have the opportunity to work with her on developing their improvisation skills and to explore alternative styles of string playing. The camp will take place on the OSU campus at the Seretean Center for the Performing Arts. Please join us for this event!
