In addition, students in grade 12 may use their competition performance as their audition for entrance into the OSU Music Program and application for scholarship consideration. Please indicate this preference on the entry form.

Eligibility:

Contestants must be violin, viola, cello or bass students currently enrolled in grades 10 through 12. Additionally, home-schooled students are welcome. Private students of OSU string faculty members may participate in order to receive comments but are not eligible to win.

Repertoire:

Contestants must perform from memory two works from the standard solo repertoire. The works must be from contrasting style periods with a minimum length of no less than 5 minutes and a maximum length of no more than 15 minutes. Please provide the judges with a score (original print version, no photocopies) for both works, with measures numbered. The contestant must provide his/her own pianist if the chosen repertoire requires piano accompaniment.

Entry Fee:

Please submit a non-refundable entry fee of \$40.00 per student with the entry form. Please make checks payable to 'OSU Department of Music.'

Deadline:

Registrations must be postmarked by Monday, January 22. Audition times and further information will be mailed to entrants by Monday, January 29.
